

African Safari

Across the great continent of Africa, there are many safaris offered. From these we have selected only a couple that we think are unique, and offer you rare up close opportunities for experiencing the land the way it was meant to.

Greater Kruger Walking Safari

Kruger NP has Private Reserves adjoining its western borders. There are no fences between the Kruger and the Reserves, hence the name Greater Kruger NP. The big advantage of these Reserves is their privacy, so no sharing sightings or camps with other tourists. Once you're out there it's just you, your ranger and chef and the rest of your party of 8.

Day 1: On the day of departure you will be collected from your hotel at first light and transferred to the reserve gate. After lunch, we transfer you into open safari vehicles to one of our bush camps in Klaserie or Timbavati Private Nature Reserve.

Days 2-4: Enjoying the cool morning air we may walk directly from camp or else use a vehicle to get further out. Your ranger will decipher the tracks and signs left by the passing animals during the night. The thrill of walking, tracking and getting up close to one of the creatures of the bush is an unforgettable experience. The afternoon activity is a walk/drive combination, looking for tracks and activity in other areas. After the walk we drive to a beautiful spot in the Reserve while waiting for an African Sunset.

Day 5: On the day of departure you will still go out for one last walk. Then we say our goodbyes and transfer you back to the city.

Accommodation

The Bush Camps are either tented or thatched and all situated on rivers. They are private 8-bedded camps with either two-bedded rooms or large walk-in tents with beds, linen, duvets, pillows etc. provided. The ablution facilities are separate with (open) hot showers and flush toilets. Each trail goes to two different camps in different reserves. All camps are secured.

Botswana Classic

Departures: Jan 09, 30, Feb 5, Mar 13, Apr 4, May 15, Jun 5, 26, Jul 3, 31, Aug 7, 28, Sep 4, 18, Oct 13, 30, Nov 20, Dec 23

The Botswana Classic Deluxe Safari is a semi-participating Lodge safari. This means, that the participants will be responsible for performing and helping with certain tasks as i.e. setting up the overnight camps (chairs, tables), cooking meals and cleaning dishes afterwards, tidying up the campsite before leaving and packing and un-packing of the vehicle and tents. This is a group tour.

Day 1: Livingstone to Chobe National Park, Botswana. A morning departure takes you from Livingstone, Zambia and into Botswana. We'll cross the Zambezi River by ferry. Toro Lodge Chalets.

Day 2: Makgadikgadi pans, Botswana. We'll head south to Planet Baobab and stop at the Magkadikgadi Pans to have a closer look. Planet Baobab Huts.

Day 3: Maun and the Okavango Delta, Botswana. After breakfast we head out for a Bushmen Walk, experiencing the traditions and lifestyle of the Bushmen. Tonight a nocturnal game drive. Mankwe Lodge tented Camp.

Day 4: Khwai River, Botswana. Today we spend a full day in the bush on a game drive. Mankwe Lodge tented Camp.

Day 5: Moremi Game Reserve, Botswana. After having explored the Khwai area, we'll now head into the famous Moremi game reserve, known as one of the most beautiful and varied reserves in Africa with an unprecedented concentration of wildlife. Mankwe Lodge tented Camp.

Day 6: Maun, Botswana. After our game experience, we'll head back to Maun. Here you have the option of a flight over the Delta and we'll drop you off at your Lodge or at Maun Airport for your connecting flight.
